Kleberg County Appraisal District Suspends Services Inside The Appraisal District Office

Kleberg County Appraisal District will need property owners to communicate with the office by using the appraisal district drive-thru window, by phone, by e-mail or by fax.

Ernestina Flores, Chief Appraiser of Kleberg County Appraisal District would like to assure the public that during in this time of caution due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the appraisal district is dedicated to creating a safe environment that provides for the ongoing and maximum safety for the public who does business with the appraisal district and the employees of the appraisal district. The appraisal district will continue operations but will no longer provide face-to-face services to the public inside the appraisal district building starting at 8:00 a.m. Thursday, March 19, 2020 as participants of the effort to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus in the area. The appraisal district will provide services through other options, such as the appraisal district drive-thru, by phone, by e-mail or by fax. These options will be in effect until further notice.

Forms and applications that may be needed are available on the appraisal district website at www.kleberg-cad.org. Forms may also be obtained by mail or fax upon request, or by picking up at the appraisal district drive-thru. A night depository is available on the east side of the building (if facing the front of the building located on 502 E. Kleberg St.) on the right hand side located in the drive-thru lane for nightly or daily drop offs. The drive-thru will be open [from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.](#) for any questions or help that might be needed by the public. Forms can also be mailed to: Kleberg County Appraisal District, 502 E. “Social distancing is one of the best ways to support the health of the entire community, which is why the appraisal district may have to postpone some **public meetings until further notice**,” Flores said. “The appraisal district will have employees available to answer your questions by phone (361-595-5775), e-mail (klebergcad@sbcglobal.net), the drive-thru (location at 502 E.
